

## Detailed Information of ISMPP Annual Awards

### 1. PP SINGHAL MEMORIAL PI INDUSTRIES AWARD

The Society will hold competition on the theme “Plant disease control by chemical methods and strategies based on epidemiological investigations” for the members of the society. There will be two cash awards of ₹ 25,000/- for winner and ₹ 15,000/- for runner.

### ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA

1. The paper should be certified that it has not been published / presented anywhere else so far and strictly should be relevant to the theme of the award.
2. Authors should be life members of Indian Society of Mycology Plant Pathology. Application form for membership can be obtained from the Society Office at Udaipur (E-mail: [ismpp2008@gmail.com](mailto:ismpp2008@gmail.com)) or download from [www.ismpp.org.in](http://www.ismpp.org.in)
3. The age of presenting scientist/author should not be above 50 years on 31st December, 2018.
4. Only single authored research paper will be considered, he/she may acknowledge his team/associates during presentation and publication.
5. Preliminary screening of the papers will be done by award committee and will approve minimum five papers for competition.
6. An earlier awards winner/qualified scientist (s)/author(s) are not eligible.
7. Only one paper can be presented by scientist/author either individually or jointly.
8. It will be binding for all qualified contestants to publish their research paper in the society's journal “*Journal of Mycology and Plant Pathology*”.
9. Award Competition will be held during the conference with a quorum of at least three participants. Otherwise, it will be cancelled.
10. Presentation will be judged by a panel of three judges and their verdict will be final and binding on all the aspects.
11. Awards will be given to winner (I prize - cash award ₹ 25,000/-, certificate and gold medal) and to runner (II prize - cash award ₹ 15,000/-, certificate, and silver medal).
12. Cash award will be distributed equally in case of more than one paper is adjudged by the jury for the same position.
13. All contestants, selected for the preliminary screening, will be paid to and from actual II class sleeper railway fare to the venue of the Annual Conference from the nearest railway station to their institution of study.

Eligible scientist/author may submit their research paper in form of abstracts (Four copies) and full length paper (two copies) strictly in the format of JMPP publication and final PowerPoint presentation along with a certificate mentioning that the author(s) is/are life member(s) and paper has not been published/ presented anywhere else so far and author is bind to publish his presented research paper in JMPP of the ISMPP ([JMPP publication guidelines available on our website www.ismpp.org.in](http://www.ismpp.org.in)).

## 2. SMT GUMAN DEVI VERMA MEMORIAL BEST WOMAN SCIENTIST AWARD

The Society will hold competition on the contributions related to aspect of Mycology and Plant Pathology for the women scientist only. [There will be cash awards of ₹ 10,000/- for winner.](#)

### ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA

1. The paper should be certified that it has not been published / presented anywhere else so far.
2. Woman scientist should be life members of Indian Society of Mycology Plant Pathology. Application form for membership can be obtained from the Society Office at Udaipur ([E-mail: ismpp2008@gmail.com](mailto:ismpp2008@gmail.com)) or download from [www.ismpp.org.in](http://www.ismpp.org.in)
3. There is no age bar for the competition.
4. Single author's research paper will be considered, she may acknowledge her team/associates during presentation and publication.
5. Preliminary screening of the papers will be done by award committee and will approve minimum five papers for competition.
6. An earlier awards winner/qualified scientist (s)/author(s) are not eligible up to the passing of 3 years.
7. Only one paper can be presented by one member either individually or jointly.
8. It will be binding for author of award participation to publish in the society's journal "[Journal of Mycology and Plant Pathology](#)".
9. Award Competition will be held during the Conference with a quorum of at least three participants. Otherwise, it will be cancelled.
10. Presentation will be judged by a panel of three judges and their verdict will be final and binding on all the aspects.
11. Awards will be given to winner (I prize - cash award ₹ 10,000/-, certificate, and gold medal) and to runner (II prize- certificate and silver medal).
12. Cash award will be distributed equally in case of more than one paper is adjudged by the jury for the same position.
13. All contestants, selected for the preliminary screening, will be paid to and fro-actual II class sleeper railway fare to the venue of the Annual Conference from the nearest railway station to their institution of study.

### 3. PR VERMA AWARD FOR M Sc AND Ph D STUDENTS

The Society will hold competition for M Sc (Ag) Plant Pathology and Ph D (Ag) Plant Pathology student's thesis paper presentation, separately. There will be two cash awards of ` 6,000/- for Ph D award winner and ` 5,000/- for M Sc award winner.

#### ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA

1. The awards competition is for the M Sc (Ag) Plant Pathology and Ph D Ag Plant Pathology students.
2. The paper should be certified that it has not been published / presented anywhere else so far.
3. The authors (student and advisor/chairman) should be member/life member of the society. Application form for membership can be obtained from the Society Office at Udaipur (E-mail: [ismpp2008@gmail.com](mailto:ismpp2008@gmail.com)) or download from [www.ismpp.org.in](http://www.ismpp.org.in)
4. Students may participate within a year of completion of M Sc (Ag) Plant Pathology and Ph D (Ag) Plant Pathology degree.
5. Student and major advisor/chairman authored research paper will be considered, he/she may acknowledge his advisory committee during presentation and publication.
6. Preliminary screening of the papers will be done by award committee and will approve minimum five papers for competition.
7. An earlier awards winner/qualified member(s) are not eligible to apply.
8. Only one paper can be presented by one member either individually or jointly.
9. It will be binding for author of award participation to publish in the society's journal "Journal of Mycology and Plant Pathology".
10. Award competition will be held during the Conference with a quorum of at least three participants, otherwise, it will be cancelled.
11. Presentation will be judged by a panel of three judges and their verdict will be final and binding on all the aspects.
12. Awards will be given to winner of Ph D students competition (I prize - cash award ` 6,000/-, certificate and gold medal) and to runner (II prize- certificate and silver medal).
13. Awards will be given to winner of M Sc students competition (I prize - cash award ` 5,000/- certificate and gold medal) and to runner (II prize- certificate and silver medal).
14. Cash award will be distributed equally in case of more than one paper is adjudged by the jury for the same prize.
15. All contestants, selected for the preliminary screening, will be paid to and fro-actual II class sleeper railway fare to the venue of the Annual Conference from the nearest railway station to their institution of study.

#### 4. YL NENE OUTSTANDING PLANT PATHOLOGY TEACHER AWARD

The Indian Society of Mycology and Plant Pathology invites nominations for Y L Nene Outstanding Plant Pathology Teacher Award for the year 2018.

##### ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA

1. The nominee should have retired from active service.
2. The award may also be posthumous. In such a situation retirement from service will not be prerequisite.
3. He / She should have been the teacher of Plant Pathology in India.
4. He / She should have guided postgraduate students' thesis research in Plant Pathology including Mycology, Bacteriology, Virology and other related fields.
5. There should be a general consensus among Indian Plant Pathologists that he/she is/was a reputed and dedicated teacher.
6. At least three of his/her students should have already been established as well known Plant Pathologists.
7. The nominee needs not to be a member of the ISMPP.
8. The decision of the award committee will be final.

##### NOMINATION PROCEDURE

1. Three well known Plant Pathologists, who have been the students of the nominee, will jointly or individually nominate their teacher for the award, giving a one page statement justifying the nomination.
2. Award committee member can nominate a teacher by providing relevant information about the nominee.

##### AWARD

Each year one award will be given. The award will consist of a shawl, a gold medal, memento and a certificate bearing a citation. The ISMPP will bear all reasonable costs related to travel (maximum 2nd AC one ticket), lodging and boarding of the awardees or his/her nominee in connection with the award presentation. The award will be presented during the inaugural function of 39<sup>th</sup> annual conference.

## 6. PROF H C DUBE OUTSTANDING YOUNG SCIENTIST AWARD

### ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA

The applicant should not be more than 45, years of age as on **December 31, 2018**. He / She should have been actively engaged in teaching / research of the discipline of Mycology and Plant Pathology. He/ She should have life membership of society and minimum ten publications in JMPP during the preceding ten years and should have contribution to the society (ISMPP). Preference will be given to the teachers/scientists who would have guided post-graduate students' research in Mycology and Plant Pathology including Bacteriology and Plant Virology. At least three important contributions by the scientist / teacher should have been made in recent years as independent scientist establishing him as a leading upcoming young scientist of the country. An earlier applicant is not applicable to apply again. The decision of the award committee will be final. The last date of receiving applications is **September 30, 2018**.

### AWARD

Each year one award will be given. The award will consist of a gold medal, memento and certificate. The award will be presented during the 39<sup>th</sup> annual conference.
