Golden Jubilee Celebration of ISMPP (1970–2021)

Creation of Indian Society of Mycology and Plant Pathology (ISMPP) was a dream of Plant Pathologists of early seventies who were inspired by doyens such as Dr N Prasad and Dr R Prasada. For quite sometimes prior to 1969, a large number of Mycologists and Plant Pathologists felt the necessity of journal to publish their research findings without delay. This need was obvious due to increasing importance of agriculture and concomitant severe biotic stress due to diseases, an increase in the number of Agriculture Universities and Research Institutions in India after independence. Consequently, an increased output of research on fundamental and applied aspects of Mycology and Plant Pathology was also required. The idea to start a new journal of Plant Pathology with its head quarter at SKN College of Agriculture, Jobner, Rajasthan was mooted with the establishment of the new Society in December, 1969. The Journal was officially rolled out entitled “Indian Journal of Mycology and Plant Pathology” with first volume in December 1971 as official organ of the society. In 1970 the Society of Mycology and Plant Pathology finally started functioning from Udaipur, Rajasthan. An interim Editorial Board was formed and late Dr N Prasad was requested to shoulder the responsibilities of publication of the Journal as Chief Editor.

During the formative phase of the Society, an academician and industrialist late Shri P P Singhal, founder of Pesticides India Ltd, Udaipur helped generously in various ways. He was the founder “Patron” of the society and initiated an annual prestigious award named as “Pesticides India Award”. Till 1981, the Journal was published twice a year in January and July, the periodicity of which was raised to three times in a year *i.e.* April, August & December and now Journal of Mycology and Plant Pathology is being published quarterly (March, June, September & December) since 2010. The Journal is abstracted by various scientific agencies over the world. The society has also started publication of ISMPP News from the year 1995. Dr Y L Nene had been the founder Editor of the Newsletter. The Society endeavored for a new venture of publishing Annual Review of Plant Pathology from year 2002.

The Society has sponsored 41 Annual Conferences till date in almost all the States of India. The society successfully organized three Global Conferences at Udaipur in the year 1995, 2005 and 2012; two Asian Congresses in 2002 at University of Mysore, Mysore and in 2007 at Osmania University, Hyderabad and one International Conference at University of Rajasthan, Jaipur in 2017.

The society has established number of prestigious awards including Y L Nene Out-standing Plant Pathology Teacher Award, Prof H C Dube Outstanding Young Scientist Award, Prof K S Bilgrami Best Poster Presentation Award, Fellow of ISMPP (FISMPP), PP Singhal Memorial PI Industries Award, Smt Guman Devi Verma Memorial Best Women Scientist Award, P R Verma Award for M Sc & Ph D students, more recently Prof S S Chahal Life Time Achievement Award from the year 2012; Dr R Prasada Memorial Best Published Paper Award from 2015 and ISMPP Honorary fellow award from the year 2021. The activities includes Presidential address, N Prasad memorial lecture; R Prasada memorial lecture; V P Bhide memorial lecture; P R Verma memorial lecture and YL Nene memorial lecture by eminent plant pathologists of the country. The Society has more than 1250 members, including annual members, life members and foreign members, institutions and libraries.

The Society holds election and/or nomination every year for the positions of President and Zonal President (North, South, East, West and SAARC countries). The Organizing Secretary for the annual/Asian/Global conference is nominated as Vice President for the ensuing year. Election and/or nomination to the offices of Secretary and Treasurer are held once in every 3 years. Number of eminent scientists of the country have served the Society in their capacities as Presidents and Secretaries sharing the responsibility of nurturing and continued development all through.

About the ANAND city, the Milk Capital of India

Anand is located at 22.57°N 72.93°E. It has an average elevation of 39 m (128 ft). Anand is the administrative centre of Anand District in the state of Gujarat, India. It is a part of the region known as Charotar, consisting of the Anand and Kheda districts.

Anand is known as the Milk Capital of India. It became famous for Amul dairy and its milk revolution by the Amul trinity: Tribhuvandas Patel, Verghese Kurien and H M Dalaya. This city hosts the Head Office of Gujarat Cooperative Milk Marketing Federation Ltd (GCMMF) NDDB of India, a well-known business school - Institute of Rural Management Anand (IRMA), Vidya Dairy and Anand Agricultural University. Another famous educational hub is Vallabh Vidyanagar, an educational suburb of Anand which has institutes like BVM (Birla Vishvakarma Mahavidhyalaya), which is the first engineering college of Gujarat, GCET (G H Patel College of Engineering and Technology), ADIT (AD Patel Institute of Technology) and Sardar Patel University which is home for around 50,000 students from all over India.

Anand lies between Ahmedabad and Vadodara on the Western Railways, 101 km from the state capital Gandhinagar. The Ahmedabad Vadodara Expressway from Ahmedabad to Vadodara also passes through Anand.

About Anand Agricultural University

Anand Agricultural University (AAU) was established in 2004 at Anand with the support of the Government of Gujarat, Act No. (Guj 5 of 2004) dated April 29, 2004. Caved out of the erstwhile Gujarat Agricultural University (GAU), the dream institution of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel and Dr K M Munshi, the AAU was set up to provide support to the farming community in three facets namely education, research and extension activities in Agriculture, Horticulture Engineering, product Processing and Home Science. At present, there are 9 Colleges, 48 Research Centers and 17 Extension Education Functionaries working in 9 districts of Gujarat namely Ahmedabad, Anand, Dahod, Kheda, Panchmahal, Vadodara, Mahisagar, Botad and Chhotaudepur.

AAU's activities have expanded to span newer sectors such as soil health card, bio-diesel, and medicinal plants apart from the mandatory ones like rice, maize, tobacco, vegetable crops, fruit crops, forage crops, animal breeding, nutrition and dairy products, *etc.* the core of AAU's operating philosophy, however, continues to create the partnership between the rural people and committed academia as the basis for sustainable rural development. In pursuing its various programmes, AAU's overall mission is to promote sustainable growth and economic independence in rural society. AAU aims to do this through education, research and extension education. Thus, AAU works towards the empowerment of the farmers.

About the Department of Plant Pathology, BACA, AAU, Anand

The Department of Plant Pathology was created in 1947. Dr M J Thirumalachar was the first Head of the Department. He was succeeded by Dr N Prasad, Dr M K Patel, Dr M V Desai, and Prof A J Patel. Under their capable leadership, the Department expanded to include many dedicated faculty members like Dr J G Patel, Dr B K Patel, Dr Ashok Mishra, Dr G B Valand, Dr R N Pandey, Dr A B Brahmhatt and many more, whose contributions made the Department as the recognized leader in the country in the field of Plant Virology, Seed Pathology, Biological control, Mushroom culture, Management of Plant diseases, *etc.*

Presently, the department is headed by Dr R G Parmar and members of the Department include 1 Associate Professor, 2 Assistant Professors, 2 technical assistants and 3 supporting staff. The entire faculty strives hard to achieve excellence in the field of education, research and extension. The department is surging ahead with the researches in the field of Plant Virology, Seed Pathology, Biological control of Plant diseases, Mushroom Culture, Management of Plant Disease, Management of Post-harvest Diseases, *etc.* The department is having 14 different projects *viz.* AICRP on Seed (Crops) Seed Technology Research & Lead

centre of seed-borne viruses and TSP project, State Non-plan for catering the need of education and plant and pest disease management; Plan Projects on Plant virology, Biocontrol of plant disease, Mushroom culture, other agency funded projects, *etc.* Besides, the department has well-developed state of art laboratories of plant virology, biological control, seed pathology and mushroom production.

Preamble

Plants are the source of the air we breathe and they make up 80 per cent of the food we eat. Healthy plants constitute the foundation of food security and are key to sustaining life on earth. Yet they are under constant attack from pests and diseases, which destroy 20 to 40 per cent of food crops every year. This leaves millions of people without enough food to eat, has a negative impact on rural poor communities' main source of income and results in both yield and trade losses. Plant health is increasingly under threat. Climate change and human activities have altered ecosystems, reducing biodiversity and creating new niches where pests can thrive. At the same time, international travel and trade have tripled in volume in the last decade and can quickly spread pests and diseases around the world causing great damage to native plants and the environment. Protecting plants from pests and diseases is far more cost-effective than dealing with full-blown plant health emergencies. Plant pests and diseases are often impossible to eradicate once they have established themselves and managing them is time-consuming and expensive. Prevention is critical to avoid the devastating impact of pests and diseases on agriculture, livelihoods and food security and many of us have a role to play. We can both prevent plant pests and diseases, and tackle them, in environmentally friendly ways - such as through integrated pest management. This ecosystem approach combines different management strategies and practices to grow healthy crops while minimizing the use of pesticides. Avoiding poisonous substances when dealing with pests not only protects the environment, it also protects pollinators, natural pest enemies, beneficial organisms and the people and animals who depend on plants. Policies and actions to promote plant health are fundamental for reaching sustainable development goals in particular those aimed at eliminating hunger and malnutrition and reducing poverty and threats to the environment. Climate change and human actions have altered ecosystems and created new niches where plant pests and diseases can thrive. Farmers should adopt and policymakers should encourage the use of environmentally friendly methods such as integrated pest management. Plant health management aims to heighten public awareness of the economic, social and environmental importance of plant health for improving global food security and the contribution of plant health towards reducing hunger and poverty.

Climate during the conference

The weather in Anand in May is really hot with a gentle breeze with average highs of 110°F (43°C) and lows of 81°F (27°C).

How to reach Anand?

Anand is approachable both by rail and by road. A large number of trains ply between Mumbai and Ahmedabad, most of them halting briefly at Anand. Anand is also directly connected by rail to other important cities of India including Bangalore, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Calcutta, Delhi, Hyderabad, Chennai and Thiruvananthapuram. Most other places that are not directly connected may be reached via a changeover at Ahmedabad, Vadodara, Mumbai, or Delhi.

Railway Station: Anand Junction (ANND)

Anand does not have an airport. The nearest airport to Anand is located in Vadodara at a distance of 42 km. Vadodara is well connected to Anand and can be reached by road, either by hiring a taxi at the airport or by catching a bus from the bus station. Second nearest airport from Anand is Ahmedabad – Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel International Airport at a distance of 95 km.
